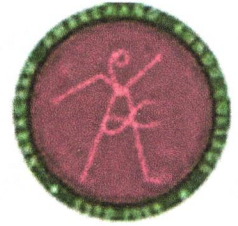




## Webinar for WBCS Exam Preparation



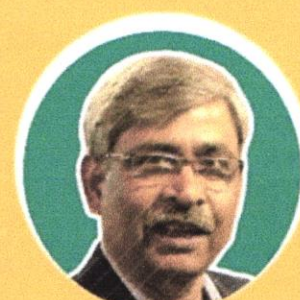


